The major work will consist of the (approximate) following:

Unit I: Construction of approximately 2,250 L.F. of 16" water line, 214 L.F. of 12" water line, and 394 L.F. of 8" water line.

Unit II: Construction of approximately 10,644 S.Y. of 10" concrete pavement, 1,463 S.Y. of HMAC pavement, 11,515 S.F. of 5' wide concrete sidewalk, and 1,344 L.F. of storm sewer.

Included in the above will be all other miscellaneous items of construction as outlined in the Plans, General Contract Documents and Specifications.

NOTICES

All bidders will be required to comply with Provision 5159a of "Vernon's Annotated Civil Statutes" of the State of Texas with respect to the payment of prevailing wage rates and City of Fort Worth Ordinance no. 7400 (Fort Worth City Code Sections 13-A-221 through 13-A-29) prohibiting discrimination in the employment practices.

Bid security is required in accordance with the Special Instruction to Bidders.

The City of Fort Worth reserves the right to reject any and/or all bids and waive any and/or all formalities.

No bid may be withdrawn until the expiration of ninety (90) days from the date bids are opened. The award of contract, if made, will be within ninety (90) days after the opening of bids, but in no case will the award be made until all the necessary investigations are made as to the responsibility of the bidder to whom it is proposed to award the Contract.

Bidders are responsible for obtaining all Addenda to the contract documents and acknowledging receipt of the Addenda by initialing the appropriate spaces on the PROPOSAL form. Bids that do not acknowledge receipt of all addenda may be rejected as being non-responsive. All addenda will be made available on-line with the contract documents. AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAGINAW, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 42, "HEALTH AND SANITATION", ARTICLE IV, "FOOD AND FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS", OF THE SAGINAW CITY CODE BY REVISING THE REVIEW AND PERMITTING PROCESS FOR FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE OF ALL ORDINANCES; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS HEREOF; PROVIDING A SAVINGS CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR PUBLICATION IN THE OFFICIAL NEWSPAPER AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

SECTION 4. Any person, firm, association of persons, corporation, or other organization violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed to be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, shall be fined not more than \$2,000.00 for each offense. Each day that a violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.

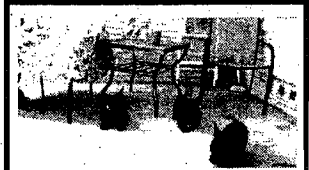
