

Municipal Energy Usage for Calendar Year 2013

The City of Saginaw purchases natural gas from Atmos Energy. In Calendar Year 2013, the City purchased a total of 1,063.83 thousand cubic feet (MCF) of natural gas.

The City purchases electricity from Direct Energy.^[1] In calendar year 2013, the City purchased a total of 4,118,099 kilowatt hours.

The City purchases water from the City of Fort Worth. In calendar year 2013, the City purchased a total of 7,541,000 gallons of water.

The total cost of natural gas, electricity and water purchased by the City in the calendar year 2013 is \$574,747.49.
